KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

DAY USE FEE:

\$7 per day, per person 13 and older.
\$3.00 per day, per person fee for climbing/rappelling.

OFFICE AND GATE INFORMATION:

Gate is open from 6am to 10pm.

Due to High volume of trail use, trails may be closed to all users after any wet weather to preserve the natural features.

Swimming allowed in designated area. Flood Alert Info Line: 940-328-1171. There are primitive sites which are available first come first serve. They are a hike in of 2 1/2 miles. No ground fires in primitive camping area.

DIRECTIONS

From Fort Worth:

Take I-20 west out of Ft. Worth. Take Exit 405 toward Ric Williamson Memorial Hwy. At the end of the off ramp turn right onto Ric Williamson Memorial Hwy. 1.4 miles ahead you will come to an intersection, stay straight. .33 of a mile you will come to another intersection, stay straight. 0.64 of a mile you will make a left hand turn onto 180 West. From this intersection you will travel approximately 12.9 miles. At the city limit sign to Mineral Wells you will see a sign Park Road 71, turn right and go .75 miles to Park Headquarters.

From Abilene:

Take I 20 East to exit 368, Hwy 281. Go North on Hwy 281 to Mineral Wells, approximately 14 miles. Take Hwy 180 East about 3 miles. Park is on the left directly off Hwy 180 on Park Road 71.

Campground: Jul 5 2019 - Dec 19 2019 :

PARK HUNT DATES: Dec.7 through Dec.11, 2019

The Crosstimbers and Primitive camping loops will be closed from 10:00PM, Dec.6 through

6:00AM, Dec 12.

PARK HUNT DATES: Dec.17 through Dec.19, 2019

All camping loops will be closed from 10:00PM, Dec.16 through 6:00AM, Dec.20.

Campground: Aug 9 2019 - Dec 31 2019 : Burn ban in effect until further notice. Fire rings are not to be used for any type of cooking/grilling/campfires. Containerized gas/Coleman type cooking stoves and charcoal is allowed in park provided grills. Contact the park for additional information.

POLICIES

TEXAS STATE PARK PASS (TSPP)

All Texas State Parks charge a daily entrance fee, in addition to site fees. Before you check in at the park, ask if you can save by purchasing a Texas State Park Pass. With a pass, you and your guests will enjoy unlimited visits for 1-year to more than 90 State Parks, without paying the daily entrance fee, in addition to other benefits. Some restrictions may apply. **All pass sales are final and non-refundable.**

State Park Pass holders receive their pass benefit (such as free entrance with a TSPP) at the time of reservation creation, provided their pass will be valid on the day of arrival. Pass holders are required to present their pass and ID upon entrance to the park. Failure to do so will result in removal of the pass discount from the order.

Reservation Change and Cancellation Rules

You can make changes or cancel your reservation on the reservation website or by calling 512-389-8900 during our normal business hours.

To cancel outside our normal business hours, you can cancel online or email customer.service@tpwd.texas.gov.

TPWD will not apply transaction/penalty charges if customers:

Change or cancel a reservation within 24 hours of when the reservation was created.

Extend a reservation.

Upgrade a reservation to a higher priced site or activity (ticket/tour).

Change a reservation to a different site in the same site type and at the same fee.

If none of the above conditions apply, TPWD will apply transaction/penalty charges if Customers:

Drop any dates on a reservation.

Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.

Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity (ticket/tour) in the same park.

Change and Cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved:

1. Overnight Camping; Includes individual campsites and screened shelters:

Change Overnight Camping Reservation:

Penalty = \$10 or amount paid (excluding entrance fees), whichever is less.

Reduce number of nights less than 5 days from the arrival date, upon arrival, or after arrival:

Penalty = \$10 per night reduced with the maximum penalty capped at \$50. If a site's price is less than \$10, the penalty per night will be set at the cost of the site.

Cancel 5 days or more before the arrival date:

Penalty = \$10 or amount paid (excluding entrance fees), whichever is less.

Cancel less than 5 days from the arrival date:

Penalty = \$10 per night with the maximum penalty capped at \$50. If a site's price is less than \$10 the penalty will be set at the cost of the site.

Do not cancel and do not show up:

Penalty = forfeiture of the entire amount paid (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

Campsite cancellation policies for group reservations may differ.

2. Overnight Lodging; Includes Yurts, Cabins, Lodges and Lodge Rooms:

Change Overnight Lodging Reservation:

Penalty = \$25 or amount paid (excluding entrance fees), whichever is less.

Reduce number of nights less than 5 days from the arrival date, upon arrival, or after arrival:

Penalty = \$25 per night reduced with the maximum penalty capped at \$75. If a site's price is less than \$25 the penalty will be set at the cost of the site.

Cancel 5 days or more before the arrival:

Penalty = \$25 or amount paid (excluding entrance fees), whichever is less.

Do not cancel and do not show up:

Penalty = forfeiture of the entire amount paid (excluding any entrance fee amount paid)

Lodging cancellation policies for group reservations may differ.

Cancel 5 days or more before the arrival:

Penalty = \$25 or amount paid (excluding entrance fees), whichever is less

Cancel less than 5 days from the arrival date:

Penalty = \$25 per night with the maximum penalty capped at \$75. If a site's price is less than \$25 the penalty will be set at the cost of the site

Do not cancel and do not show up:

Penalty = forfeiture of the entire amount paid (excluding any entrance fee amount paid)

Lodging cancellation policies for group reservations may differ.

3. Group Sites; Including Group Camping Areas, Barracks/Bunkhouse, Pavilion, Picnic Area, Group Hall, Amphitheatre, Auditorium, Gymnasium, Pool:

Change reservation more than 6 months before arrival date:

Penalty = 25% of the reservation (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

Changes reservation 6 or fewer months before arrival date:

Penalty = 50% of the reservation (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

Cancel more than 6 months before the arrival date:

Penalty = 25% of the reservation (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

Cancel 2 months to 6 months before the arrival date:

Penalty = 50% of the reservation (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

Cancel less than 2 months before the arrival date or do not cancel and do not show up:

Penalty = 100% of the reservation (excluding any entrance fee amount paid).

If the amount paid does not cover the transaction/penalty charges the transaction/penalty charged will be limited to the amount previously paid.

All pre-paid entrance fees are refunded.

Fees and charges are subject to change at any time. If site fees change, we will honor the fees in effect when you made the reservation, as long as you do not change the reservation. If you make changes, we will apply the new fees.

Additional Information

CLOSURES: Occasionally Parks must close due to weather, maintenance, or construction issues. Should this occur at the Park or for the Site you have reserved, you will be notified by email at the email address you provided for your customer account. Closures will also be posted on the TPWD Website.

PETS: Pets must be attended and on a six-foot leash at all times, including while in rivers or lakes. Pets are not allowed in any park buildings, cabins, or shelters. Customer must provide proof of current vaccinations for each pet entering the park.

HORSES: For Parks that allow horses - All horses entering the park, must have a negative Coggins test less than 12 months old.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Public consumption or display of an alcoholic beverage is prohibited.

FIREWOOD: Gathering of firewood is prohibited. Use local firewood to protect your state parks from invasive insects and diseases. Don't bring firewood from home; burn it where you buy it!

WILDLIFE: Feeding of wildlife is prohibited.

ALLIGATORS: Alligators do reside in some of our Texas State Parks.
